The date for the 2010 Karting Challenge is Sunday 23rd May. The event will once again be at the Speedkarting arena in Warrington which has recently undergone a number of improvements and now has the longest track in the UK with over 1,000 metres of track across 3 exhilarating levels, has the longest Monaco-style tunnel as well as the slingshot hairpin bend - all of which will really test your driving skills.

This year's event will once again consist of 20 teams each with 3 drivers. Drivers will compete in five heats of racing for the Hardware Trades Charity Trophy and the Fastest Lady Trophy. Also up for grabs will be the individual 1st, 2nd and 3rd trophies which will be awarded after the grand final in which the 8 drivers with the highest scores compete against each other. Other trophies include the Fastest Lap Trophy and the much coveted Bent Axle Award for the driver scoring the least number of points. The entry fee per team of 3 drivers is £345 + vat (£405.38). The entry fee includes personal accident insurance for all drivers and for insurance purposes **all drivers must be aged over 18 years**.

The event is a charity event with all proceeds from the day donated to our industry charity, the Rainy Day Trust. I have taken the liberty of enclosing the current Rainy Day Trust leaflet together with an application form for anyone who wishes to further help the charity by becoming a member.

Due to the popularity of this event we are initially inviting all those companies who have taken part in previous years and I would ask that if you would like to enter a team you **return the booking form** together with a cheque payable to R.M.T.B.S. This charity meeting is run under the Hardware Trades Karting Challenge race regulations, a copy of which is available on request. It is intended as a fun event and should be entered into as such. All proceeds from the meeting will be donated to the Rainy Day Trust.

SIGNING ON

Signing on will be from 08.45 - 09.15 at the circuit.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

There will be a drivers briefing at 09.45 prompt for which all drivers must attend. Any driver who misses the briefing **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE**. It is strictly forbidden to drive after having consumed alcohol, drugs or medication prescribed or otherwise during the 12 hours before the event.

PRACTISE

Practise will take place immediately after the drivers briefing with sessions starting at 10.00.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

Race suits, gloves and helmets will be provided. It is advisable, however, to wear casual clothes and soft shoes or trainers.

RACING

Drivers will be called by their race number approx. 3 minutes before their race starts and their name and number will appear on the scoreboard. They must assemble immediately in the pit area. Failure to do so may result in the race being forfeited. All drivers must be aged 18 years or over.

JUDGE OF FACT

The race director has the final say. No appeals, correspondence or tantrums will be entered into.

POINT SYSTEM

In the team event, there will be 5 drivers per race. Points will be awarded as follows; 1st 10 Points, 2nd 8 Points, 3rd 6 Points, 4th 5 Points, 5th 4 Points. Drivers will race in 5 rounds of heats and points accumulated will count towards their overall team score thus deciding the Team Trophy. Only the top eight scoring drivers from the heats will progress to the individual Grand Final.

PRIZE GIVING

The Hardware Trades Charity Trophy, presented to the team who has amassed the most points in the heats. Individual trophies for the top three drivers in the Grand Final. A Fastest Lap Trophy, Fastest Lady Trophy and the coveted Bent Axle Award for the unluckiest driver. Prize giving will take place immediately after the heats.

CATERING

The cafeteria at the circuit will be open from early morning and throughout the day.
